Studying abroad: 45 universities at the International College Day

(Hamburg, 8 September 2015) The International College Day is Germany's largest independent education fair for English-speaking studies abroad. On Wednesday, 23 September the CollegeCouncil will organize the sixth edition of the fair on the premises of the International School of Hamburg (ISH). Interested students from Hamburg and the surrounding region are cordially invited. The entry is free of charge, but registration on www.collegeday.de is kindly requested.

More and more students want to gather valuable experiences abroad. But how can they find the offer that is right for them? Students and parents will find the answer and more at the International College Day. The fair offers first hand information, useful brochures, application forms, a chance to compare offers and – first and foremost – the opportunity to clarify important questions in person. Renowned universities and colleges from the U.S. (e.g. University of California, Davis), Canada (University of British Columbia), Great Britain (e.g. University of St. Andrews), France, The Netherlands, Spain, Italy, Switzerland and Austria are among the approx. 45 exhibitors. Various lectures on such topics as “German and Anglo-American study systems in comparison” will round off the fair’s program.

The College Day will be held at ISH for the second time in a row - a benefit not only to ISH students, who are systematically informed and advised regarding their school and university careers as of grade 9. “We are very pleased with our cooperation with the CollegeCouncil. During the fair, interested pupils and students from Hamburg and beyond have a chance to gain attractive insights into the various opportunities for studying abroad. With its international-mindedness and English as teaching language, our school is an ideal fit”, Head of School Andreas Swoboda explains.

The Berlin-based, independent and non-profit CollegeCouncil has been involved in international educational exchanges since 2003. It offers diverse opportunities for students, pupils, graduates, professionals and trainees to study or work abroad, mainly in English-speaking countries.

ISH was Germany's very first international school and still remains Hamburg's only educational institution accredited by the Council of International Schools.
